Social isolation and loneliness have been linked to both the physical and emotional decline of older adults.

With our Telephone Reassurance Program, staff and trained volunteers make regularly scheduled phone calls to isolated and homebound seniors to provide wellness checks and socialization.

The program serves homebound seniors age 60 and older in Muskegon County, Oceana County, and the Southwest and Southeast sections of Ottawa County.

There is no cost to participate.
